BI - E-Arrival Card Registration for Foreign Nationals Entering Brunei

Dear Valued Partner,

Effective from 9 February 2023, all foreign nationals entering Brunei through immigration control posts by sea, air, and land will be required to fill in an E-Arrival Card registration.

- Those in transit at the Brunei International Airport or any port of entry in Brunei are not required to fill in the E-Arrival Card.
- Registration can be accessed online at https://www.imm.gov.bn (can be accessed soon).
- A one-time password verification OTP will be required via email.
- The information must be filled out before arriving in Brunei.
- One registration can be used to apply for other travelers such as children, infants, etc.
- Documents required for the registration are a valid travel document or passport, a residential address in Brunei Darussalam, and flight details.
- E-Arrival Card is not a visa or pass and must be applied for separately.
- Confirmation of E-Arrival Card registration is not an approval for entry into the country and is still subject to further inspection on arrival.
- No payment is required for the E-Arrival Card registration.
